

## Crazy Block – quick and easy.

Make three strip sets of four different fabrics, 2.5 inch wide strips. Press seams to one side. Measure the strip set. It should be 8.25 inches. Cut the strips into 8.25 x 8.25 inch squares. Place two squares together, right sides together. Turn the top block 45 degrees to the right so you have the bottom block strips vertical and the top block horizontal. Pin together and sew a ¼ inch seam all around the block (all sides). Use a ruler and make 2 cuts - diagonally from one corner to the other (like an X). Open the pieces and carefully press. You end up with four, 5.5 x 5.5 squares. Square up to 5.5 if needed. Arrange blocks how you like. You can alternate with plain 5.5 blocks. Sew in rows, add a border and you're finished!
