

## Two Color-Disappearing Four Patch Block

Cut (2) five-inch squares of first fabric.

Cut (2) five-inch squares of second contrasting fabric.

Lay out squares with opposite colors touching. Sew the patches into a 4-patch block using 1/4" seams. Press.



Measure and slice one-inch along both sides of vertical seam. Without moving pieces, slice one-inch along both sides of horizontal seam.



Arrange cut pieces so they will be next to opposite colored pieces.



Sew each row together using 1/4" seams.



Sew the three rows into a block.



The finished block will measure 8 1/2 inches x 8 1/2 inches.
