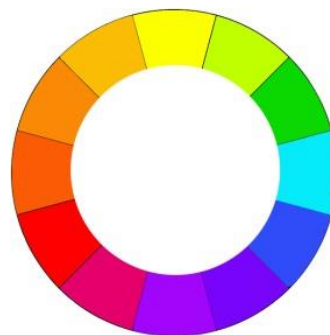

COLOR *it* BEAUTIFUL



Color Wheel:

- Each swatch represents a family
- Colors arranged according to similarities and differences

Temperature:

- Warm colors = fire: red, orange, and yellow
- Cool colors = green, blue, and purple
- Balance = "A little bit of fire"

Complementary (opposite) color combinations:

- Green / Red
- Purple / Yellow
- Blue / Orange

Other:

- Value & Intensity

Challenges:

- Make or buy a color wheel
- Observe colors everywhere!
- Try complementary colors
- Use balanced proportions of warm and cool colors
- Use a new color
