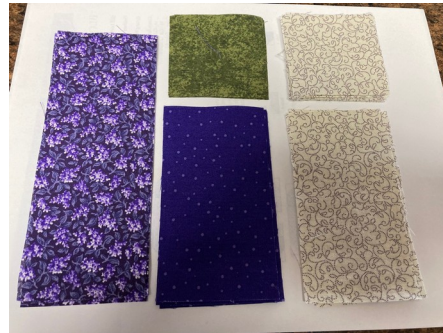


Spinning Four-Patch Block

Fabric and Cutting:

- Background: (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
(12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
- Center Square: (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
- Dark Solid: (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- Dark Print: (4) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles



Assembly:

Draw diagonal line on back of (8) background 2 1/2" squares.

Place a background 2 1/2" square on right end of dark solid rectangle. Stitch on diagonal line as shown. Trim 1/4" away from seam. Press seam toward outside. (Make 4)



Place background 2 1/2" square on right end of print rectangle. Stitch on diagonal line as shown. Trim 1/4" away from seam. Press seam toward outside. (Make 4)



Assembly:

Stitch center 2 1/2" square (green) to background 2 1/2" square along one side. Press towards the dark.

With center (green) square on the right, stitch a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" background rectangle on top of them. Press toward outside of block.

Stitch dark 4 1/2" rectangle to right side of previous portion of block as shown. Press seam toward outside of block.



Stitch dark print 6 1/2" rectangle to bottom as shown. Press toward outside of block.

This will make a 6 1/2" square.



Using four similar 6 1/2" blocks arrange as shown below.



Stitch together into a 4-patch block. This will make a 12 1/2" square block.
