

Springtime Flower Quilt Block

Materials: change up the colors however you like. The directions are written to duplicate the block pictured above.

Color 1 (from photo) green – cut 2- 2 7/8 inch squares

Color 2 (from photo) dark purple – cut 4- 2 1/2 inch squares and 2 -2 7/8 inch squares

Color 3 (from photo) light purple – cut 4 – 2 1/2 inch squares

Color 4 (from photo) yellow – cut 1 – 2 1/2 inch square

Color 5 (from photo) white (background) cut 8 – 2 1/2 inch squares, cut 4-2 7/8 inch squares

To make a half square triangle (HST)

1. Place 2 squares of fabric right sides together (RST)
2. Draw a line diagonally on one side of the 2 squares RST from one corner to the opposite side
3. Sew 1/4 inch on each side of the drawn line
4. Cut along the drawn line, open the fabric pieces and press seams to the dark. Trim to 2 1/2 inch square depending on how accurate your cutting and sewing is

Make four HST using fabric 1 and 5 (green and white) using the 2 7/8 inch squares

Make four HST using fabric 2 and 5 (dark purple and white) using the 2 7/8 inch squares

Assemble five rows of five squares as shown in the sample, placing your half square triangles in position as indicated in the sample.

Sew row 1 with 5 squares together, pressing seems in alternate directions on each row. Match seams of the rows and sew the rows together to make a 25 unit block that should measure 10.5 x 10.5
